EXPERIENCE AND KNOWLEDGE

Dr. Georg Hengstberger began his professional career in risk controlling at Baden-Württembergische Bank. This applies in particular to regulatory

requirements in the areas of capital markets and credit processes. Therefore, due to his professional experience in the banking sector, as well as being the managing director of a medium-sized investment company, he has comprehensive knowledge and expertise in the topics of accounting, the accounting regulations according to HGB and IFRS, as well as the special issues of preparing annual financial statements.
