## Entry control procedure for trucks at PWO



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- ➤ The truck driver turns into the "Tor1" truck entrance. The truck driver drives to a signposted truck parking lot and parks the truck.
- > Then, the driver walks to the self-service terminal which is located at the registration area beside the entrance.
- > The **registration data** must be entered via a touch display by the driver **himself/herself**. Registration takes place in the **language selected** by the driver.
- > During registration, the driver must **confirm and sign the PWO safety guidelines**. Only after signing does the driver automatically **receive a pager at the terminal**.
- > With this pager, the truck driver **returns to** his/her **truck**, where he/she waits until **his/her name is called**.
- > The driver receives the **call for entry via the pager**. He/She receives a message on the **pager's** plain text **display** indicating the **destination** that he/she must drive to.

## • Exception:

If the destination displayed is "H08-Office", the truck driver leaves his/her truck on the parking lot and walks to the shipping office located in hall 08, going through the turnstile at the entrance. Here, the pager gives him/her access to the company premises. When the driver has finished at the shipping office, he/she again leaves the company premise through the turnstile. He/she still keeps the pager.

- For **all other destinations** the truck driver drives **directly** in front of the **entrance gate**. In order to **open the gate**, the driver identifies himself/herself **with the help of the pager** at the gate terminal. The gate opens and the truck driver can pass through.
- ➤ The gate only opens if the driver has received the call for entrance. After the call, the driver has 20 minutes to pass the gate. If this does not happen within the predefined time, entrance is blocked.
- The truck driver prepares his/her truck for loading and unloading. When doing so, he/she is obliged to open the truck's side cover and tail gate. Instructions from PWO employees given in this context must absolutely be obeyed by the truck driver at all times.
- > The goods are loaded by the forklift operator. Then, the **truck driver must make the loading secure**.
- At the **exit gate** the **pager** must be **inserted in the returns shaft**. When the pager is returned, the **exit gate is opened** and the truck driver may leave the PWO premises.
